EC Maritime Law Course

This course will be inaugurated by: H.E. Dr. Joe Borg, EU Commissioner for Fisheries and Maritime Affairs

The Course offers an overview of the maritime dimension of EU policy, as reflected in the various rules and legislation covering fisheries, coastal zone management and marine environmental protection. Focus is also placed on shipping. The Course delves into the intricate EU rules on maritime competition, ship safety and environmental protection. "Post-Erika" developments in the field of maritime safety and pollution prevention and liability are canvassed in the context of the role of the EU and its member States within the International Maritime Organization. The Course also covers a discussion on the new EU Green Paper on Maritime Policy. A general introduction to the EU institutional framework and external policy is also provided.

Key topics to be examined in this course include: $\sqrt{\text{EC}}$ institutions and external policy

- $\sqrt{\rm Overview}$ of EC maritime law, with an emphasis on shipping law
- √ EC ship safety and pollution prevention/liability, including "*post-Erika* packages"
- $\sqrt{\text{EC}}$ legal framework on ship source pollution
- $\sqrt{\text{EC}}$ maritime competition law
- $\sqrt{\text{EC}}$ maritime transport external relationships
- $\sqrt{\text{EC}}$ Fisheries policies
