FEW PLACES AVAILABLE FOR THE 26TH LL.M. PROGRAMME IN INTERNATIONAL MARITIME LAW

The admissions process of the IMO International Maritime Law Institute (IMLI) for the academic year 2014/2015 is well underway. The Institute has received numerous applications from all over the world and several donors have agreed to sponsor the studies of deserving candidates nominated by their respective governments.

To ensure the quality training that has characterized the Institute since its inception, the number of students admitted in the programme is restricted and therefore admission to the programme is highly competitive. As it is now tradition, limited places are reserved for qualified candidates who have secured funding for their studies (either through their employers or their own means) and are seeking enrolment in the programme. At the moment, very few places remain available for these candidates whose applications are being considered on a first come first serve basis. The deadline for the acceptance of such applications is set at 1 August 2014.
