

IMLI STUDENTS AND STAFF SAFE AS COVID-19 PANDEMIC DEEPENS

The Director of the IMO International Maritime Law Institute (IMLI), Professor David Attard, would like to bring to the attention of our readers that all staff members and students continue to work taking into account the highest standards of safety. For this purpose, the Director has set up the COVID-19 Emergency Team to provide for response measures in the light of the rapidly developing crisis. Such important measures relate, inter alia, to the transferring of all lecturing and supervision of academic projects to online platforms, continuous sterilization of the Institute's premises and students rooms, suspending of the visiting fellows programme, and not allowing external visitors to enter the premises. In the light of the ever-increasing challenges, the Institute continues, through its Emergency Team, to develop several contingency plans to protect staff and students whilst ensuring the continuity of its teaching and research mission.

As the situation changes rapidly, the Institute will continue to be proactive in protecting the health, safety and well-being of the staff members and students by implementing all the necessary measures required in order to maintain a safe environment so as to enable the students to successfully complete their studies at IMLI.

The Institute will continue to issue regular updates to keep its readers informed of additional measures.
