



IMLI TAKES FURTHER SAFETY MEASURES AS THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 ESCALATES

The Director of IMLI, Professor David Attard, would like to bring to the attention of the readers that additional measures have been taken by the Institute in order to ensure that the health and safety of its students are protected. As the Institute has transferred the lecturing to online platforms, it has provided students with the option of leaving Malta as soon as possible. Arrangements for their examination have also been made.

Further, whilst supervision of academic projects continues online, the deadline for submission of both Maritime Legislation Drafting Projects and Dissertations / Research Projects has also been postponed to August.

For those students who have opted to remain in Malta to complete their course of studies, the Institute is currently holding intensive lectures to be followed by revision classes online.
