It is with profound sadness that the Institute informs its readers of the passing away of one of its alumni, Vice Admiral Mike Okhai Akhigbe.

Mr. Akhigbe attended IMLI during the academic year 2001-2002. He was very focused on his academic work and achieved very good results. His areas of research for his Dissertation and Maritime Legislation Drafting Project were on the “*Enforcement of Maritime Law: The Nigerian Perspective*” and “*Maritime Security Act 2000*” respectively. At the time of his studies at the Institute, he was already a Vice-Admiral in the Nigerian Navy.
