27th ANNUAL LL.M. PROGRAMME COMMENCES

IMLI's 27th Master of Laws (LL.M.) programme in International Maritime Law commenced on Monday 12 October, 2015. During the academic year 2015-2016, thirty-five lawyers from twenty-six countries will pursue their LL.M. studies at the Institute. Turkmenistan is being represented for the first time in the Institute's LL.M. programme. In addition, the Institute has several candidates from different countries, including Brazil, Malta, Nigeria, Pakistan and Poland, who will attend its Advanced Diploma programme in International Maritime Law and its short courses in the various areas of both Shipping Law and the Law of the Sea.
