The delegation's visit to IMLI was part of its Five-day Study Visit to Malta on Maritime Border Management and Irregular and Mixed Migration under the aegis of MIEUX - MIgration EU

eXpertise, supported by the European Union (EU) and implemented by the International Centre for Migration Policy Development (ICMPD).

During the visit, the delegation was briefed about the Institute, its mandate, activities and academic programmes. The delegation was informed about the Institute's long-standing cooperation with the Government of Nigeria which entrusted the training in international maritime law of many senior government officials, the majority of whom came from the Nigeria Maritime and Safety Administration (NIMASA) and the Nigeria Ports Authority (NPA). The delegation was also informed about the valuable role Mr. Louis Mbanefo (a Nigerian renown lawyer, and member of the IMLI Governing Board) played towards the development of the Institute, more particularly the development of the Institute's curriculum.
