During the Graduation Ceremony, Fifty-one students (from 41 countries) in total graduated from the Institute's programmes. Forty-two students were awarded the Degree of Master of Laws (LL.M.) in International Maritime Law and seven students were awarded the Degree of Master of Humanities (M.Hum.) in International Maritime Legislation. Two more students were awarded an Advanced Diploma in International Maritime Law.

In his address, Professor David Attard (Director, IMLI) welcomed the dignitaries to the graduation ceremony and invited Mr. Kitack Lim (Secretary-General, IMO) to deliver the graduation address. The Valedictory Speech was delivered by Ms. Thandi Rosalea McAllister (Guyana), on behalf of the IMLI Class of 2017-2018.
