## **IMLI AWARDS THE PROFESSOR WALTER MÜLLER PRIZE FOR THE BEST MARITIME LEGISLATION DRAFTING PROJECT**

Ms. Morlette L. Johnson (the Bahamas) was awarded the Professor Walter Müller Prize for the Best Maritime Legislation Drafting Project during the Institute's 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Graduation Ceremony held at the Malta Maritime Museum, Vittoriosa, Malta on 9 June 2018. The Prize (the Professor Walter Müller Prize for the Best Maritime Legislation Drafting Project) is awarded to a student whose Maritime Legislation Drafting Project is adjudged best for the academic year. Ms. Johnson, the winner of the Prize for the 2017-2018 academic year, is a senior State Counsel and Attorney-at-Law, Office of the Attorney General of the Bahamas. Her Drafting

Project is entitled 'Control of Harmful Anti-Fouling Systems on Ship Act, 2018'. It is expected that her Project will be incorporated into the national laws of the Bahamas.
