The IMLI Treatise on Global Ocean Governance is a result of the IMLI - Nippon Foundation Project on Global Ocean Governance. The Project could be described as a timely response to the concerns raised by Dr Yohei Sasakawa (Chairman of The Nippon Foundation) in his address to the International Maritime Organization (IMO), where he mentioned the need to establish a new framework for ocean governance that will effectively solve the problems of the oceans.

The Contributions to the Treatise came from fifty-eight (58) leading experts. The Treatise assesses the current state of ocean governance to ensure that proposals for a new framework are based on reliable information. The Treatise covers the vast spectrum of global ocean governance in three volumes and has Professor David Joseph Attard (the Director of IMLI) as the General Academic Coordinator and Editor. It was published by Oxford University Press (OUP) on 26 July 2018.
