The IMO International Maritime Law Institute (IMLI) welcomed its 30th generation of students for the 2018-2019 academic year on 22 October 2018.

He informed the students that IMLI was set up to train maritime lawyers from developing countries on the whole spectrum of maritime law and how to incorporate and effectively implement IMO treaties and guidelines into domestic law.

Professor Attard noted that IMLI's uniqueness is reflected, among other things, in its unique syllabus which considers maritime law from an international perspective and the cultural and legal diversity of its students. He encouraged the students to embrace this rare opportunity for both
