During an interview with the Website Administrator, Ms. Claudette Camilleri, she explained that the reason for the new website stems from the fact that the former one, which was developed on an older system, was not as responsive as in the past and therefore it needed revamping. As the IMLI Website is an especially important tool of information on and promotion of the Institute, it was decided by the Institute's Director that a new, more modern and efficient website should be launched.

Through its various pages, visitors can learn about the Institute, its several programmes and courses, its numerous publications, as well as the donors who have supported the Institute's activities throughout the years. Details of the Institute's governing bodies, its Academic and Administrative Staff, and the over 1,000 maritime experts from 145 States and territories who have received training at IMLI can be found in the "Directories" page. The page on "Useful Links" provides access to international maritime law treaties and legislative instruments and other maritime law links.

In highlighting the effect of the work done on the new website, Ms. Camilleri stated that it is more user friendly and for its operation, the latest technology has been employed so as to allow much easier access to the website, while at the same time facilitating its maintenance and constant update. The latest technology will also make the website compatible with all devices, including mobile phones and with all major Web Browsers, thus ensuring more visibility and visits.

Professor Attard expressed his satisfaction with the Institute's new website and commented that, "We are pleased to introduce the new website which takes into account the latest technology and reflects contemporary life at IMLI."
