Prof. Mary H. Durfee (Ph.D. Cornell), Visiting Fulbright Professor to the Faculty of Law, University of Malta is currently delivering a series of lectures from the field of Public International Law, in particular on Jurisdiction and State Responsibility.

Prof. Durfee is an Associate Professor in Department of Social Sciences and an Assistant Provost (associate pro rector) in academic affairs of the Michigan Technological University, Houghton, USA. She is also a member of the US Environmental Protection Agency's Science Advisory Board and in the academic year 2006 – 2007 she chaired the International Law Section of the International Studies Association, USA. Prof. Durfee is a political scientist, with specialized training in international relations and comparative public policy. She teaches international law, US foreign policy, and international environmental technology policy. She is the co-author with James N. Rosenau of an international relations book, *Thinking Theory Thoroughly*, now in its second edition. In her home-country, Prof. Durfee regularly publishes, individually and in co-authorships, and has taken part in some significant US and international

scientific research projects. Her central research interest is the management of the Great Lakes of North America. More generally, she is interested in water policy. In that context, she has also done work on pollution prevention.
