DIRECTOR OF IMLI DELIVERS A LECTURE AT THE ITALIAN NAVAL ACADEMY

Professor David Attard, Director of the IMO International Maritime Law Institute, was recently invited by the Italian Naval Academy based in Livorno to lecture on the "Exercise of High Seas' Freedoms outside the High Seas" at the Auditorium of the Italian Nautical Academy. His lectures were delivered to an audience of around 200 Naval Officers who are currently attending the 4th and 5th year at the Academy and belonging to the following different Navy Corps: Line Officers (Stato Maggiore), Supply Officers (Commissariato) and Coast Guard (Capitanerie di Porto).

Professor Attard was introduced to the audience by Navy Captain Bruno Concina, Director of the Academic Department. Rear Admiral Fabio Caffio was present at the event, representing the Italian Navy General Staff.
