

## **ARMED FORCES OF MALTA AND OVERSEAS STUDENTS ATTEND IMLI'S SHORT COURSE ON THE LAW OF THE SEA**

IMLI organized a short course on the Law of the Sea for the Armed Forces of Malta and overseas students. IMLI's course is part of the Operational Maritime Law Course organized, for the first time this year by the Armed Forces of Malta (AFM) Maritime Safety and Security Training Centre (MSSTC). It was delivered by Dr. Norman Martínez (Lecturer, IMLI) and focused on the regimes of International Straits, Archipelagic States, Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf.

Dr. Martínez explained how the 1982 United Nations Convention on Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) regulates these regimes and the practice of different States in implementing the UNCLOS provisions.
