The Legal Committee of the International Maritime Organization held its ninety-seventh session at its Headquarters between 15 and 19 November.

During this meeting the Committee discussed many topical issues including inter alia fair treatment of seafarers, piracy, possible amendments to the limits of liability included in the LLMC Convention, the implementation of the Bunkers Convention, a report on the Conference on the revision of the HNS Convention and a new proposal to consider issues relating to the liability and compensation for oil pollution damage resulting from offshore oil exploration and exploitation activities.
