During a reception tendered in honor of the Spanish Ambassador, the IMLI Director, Professor David Attard, stressed the special position Spain enjoys in maritime history, in the discovery of the New World and the influence it has made on the Latin American countries. He pointed out the role that these Latin American countries have played in influencing the discussions on the Law of the Sea.

Professor Attard introduced individually the students from Central and South America and stressed the special ties that their countries have with Spain. He showed Ms. Vilardell Coma the IMLI map which plots the States where IMLI graduates may be found.

In her response, the Spanish Ambassador acknowledged Spain's part in maritime history and was pleased to see the growing IMLI network among States.
