IMLI MOURNS THE PASSING OF PROFESSOR UMBERTO LEANZA

The Institute wishes to express its heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Professor Umberto Leanza who has recently passed away. Professor Leanza was a full Professor of International Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Rome "Tor Vergata". He was Head of Diplomatic Litigation, Treaties and Legislative Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Professor Leanza served as President of the Scientific Committee of the Italian Society for the Protection of Cultural Heritage (SIPBC) and President of the Italian Society of International Law. In addition, Professor Leanza has held the position of Honorary President of the Alcide de Gasperi Institute of European Studies.
