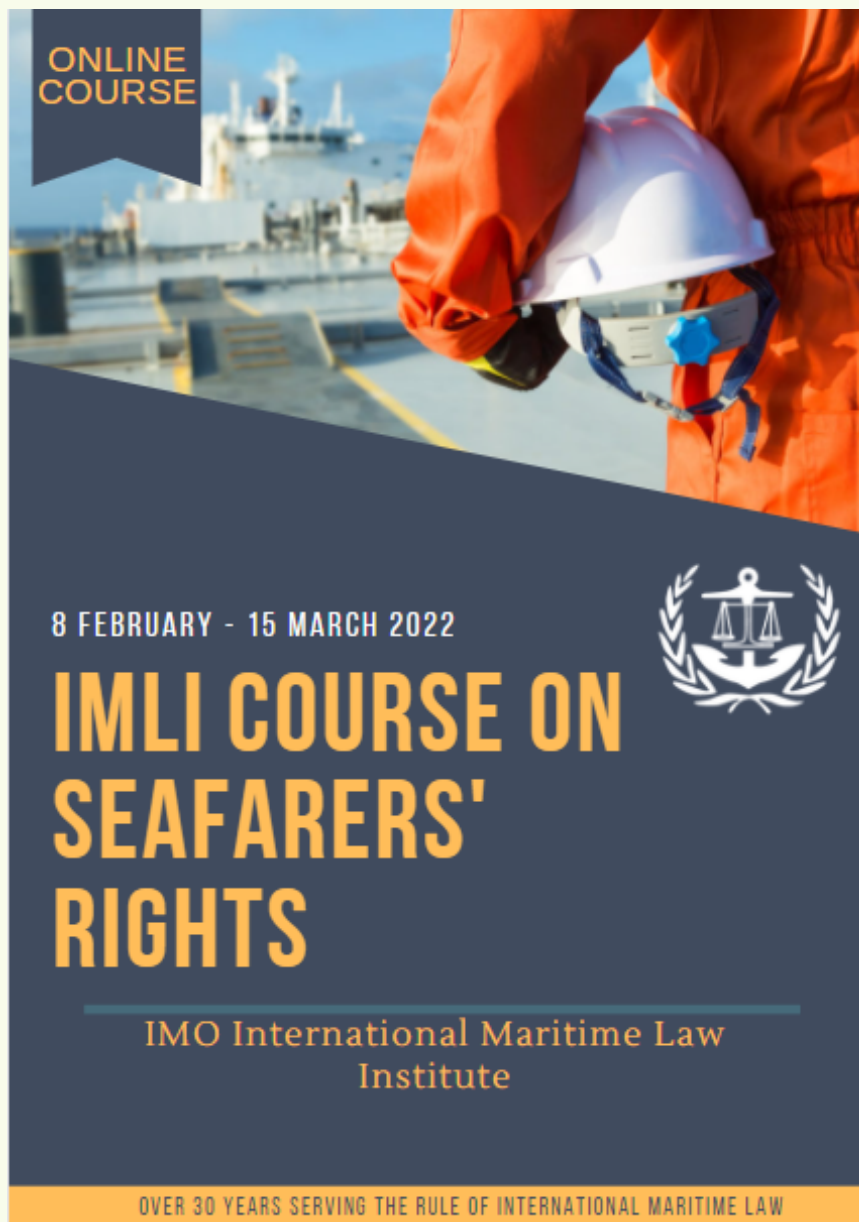

THE SECOND ANNUAL IMLI COURSE ON SEAFARERS' RIGHTS TO COMMENCE ON 8 FEBRUARY 2022



IMLI wishes to remind its readers of the forthcoming commencement of its Second Annual Course on Seafarers' Rights on 8 February 2022. The Institute is pleased to announce that the IMLI Course on Seafarers' Rights will be inaugurated by Ms. Beatriz Vacotto (Head of the Maritime Unit, International Labour Standards Department, ILO).



The Course will address many aspects of maritime labour law, including the characteristics of international maritime labour law, the functions of ILO, IMO, ITF and other organizations committed to the protection of seafarers' rights. The Course will guide participants to the practical application of the different international instruments dealing with seafarers, their rights and duties, with particular emphasis on the Maritime Labour Convention, including its amendments, and the efforts being made to limit the effect of the pandemic on seafarers worldwide.
