DISTINGUISHED JUDGES FROM ITLOS CONTINUE TO DELIVER LECTURES AT IMLI

Judge Tomas Heidar (Vice-President of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS)), delivered a lecture on 17 May to the IMLI Class of 2021-2022 and external government officers entitled "The Contribution of ITLOS to the Protection of the Marine Environment." He was introduced by Professor Judge David Attard (Director, IMLI), who expressed his delight to have him deliver a lecture at IMLI and informed the audience that Judge Heidar combines a remarkable legal and diplomatic career.

The distinguished Judges delivered their lectures on 17 May to over 70 government officers who are attending the IMLI Course on Peaceful Settlement of Maritime Disputes. Judge Cabello, who has been a Member of the Tribunal since October 2017, addressed the audience on the topic of "Advisory Opinion on Fishing in the EEZ of other States (case no. 21)." He was introduced by Professor Judge Attard (Director, IMLI), who noted that Judge Cabello is renowned lawyer, diplomat and academic.

In introducing Judge Kamga, Professor Judge Attard informed the participants that he has been a Member of the Tribunal since October 2020 and is a friend of the Institute, having visited it in the past as a distinguished visiting lecturer. Prior to being elected as ITLOS Judge, Judge Kamga was the Legal Secretary of the International Court of Justice (ICJ). His lecture was entitled "The Contribution of ICJ to the Development of the Law on Settlement of Maritime Disputes."

REGISTRAR OF ITLOS LECTURES AT IMLI






