## THE IMLI GOVERNING BOARD HOLDS ITS 36TH SESSION



The 36th session of the IMLI Governing Board (the Board) was held virtually on 19 July 2022. The session was chaired by Mr. Kitack Lim (Secretary-General, IMO and Chairman, IMLI Governing Board) and attended by Vice-Admiral Cristiano Aliperta, Professor David Attard, Professor Philippe Boisson, Ambassador Victor Camilleri, Dr. Reto Dürler, Mr. Jim Harrison, Professor Atsuko Kanehara, Ms. Nancy Karigithu, Mr. Louis N. Mbanefo, Dr. Kofi Mbiah, Professor Marko Pavliha, and Mr. Xiaojie Zhang. Professor Norman Martinez, Ms. Sivylla Ampatzoglou and Ms. Galuh Rarasanti attended the session as observers.

The Board reviewed the financial and academic progress of the Institute for the period between 1 July 2021 and 1 June 2022.

The Board expressed its wish that Professor Attard will maintain close links with the Institute and continue to support and promote its work in the future.
