




On 9 February 2023, IMLI commenced its annual Specialized Course on Seafarer's Rights. Ms. Beatriz Vacotto (Head of the Maritime Unit, International Labour Standards Department, International Labour Organization [ILO]) delivered online the Inaugural Lecture of this Specialized Course.

Ms. Vacotto was introduced to the IMLI Class of 2022-2023 and the external Course participants by Professor Dr. Norman A. Martínez Gutiérrez (Director, IMLI), who stressed the importance of the role of the seafarers to the maritime industry, affirming that they are essential workers and emphasizing the need to ensure that they enjoy decent working conditions.
