IMLI TO WELCOME THE 37TH GENERATION OF MARITIME PROFESSIONALS

The IMO International Maritime Law Institute (IMLI) will welcome the 37th generation of maritime professionals on Wednesday, 1 October, 2025. The newly admitted students of the academic year 2025-2026 will be introduced to IMLI by the Director of the Institute, followed by an orientation session.

For the academic year 2025-2026, 65 students from 31 States will receive quality training in the full spectrum of international maritime law. In line with its policy of reserving 50 per cent of the places for women candidates, 31 of the students are female professionals.

We remain committed to support the IMO Member States and the international maritime community through the training of the maritime leaders of tomorrow.
