THE IMLI COURSE ON SEAFARERS' RIGHTS

The Institute is pleased to inform its esteemed readers that its annual Course on Seafarers' Rights will commence on 3 February 2026.

Labour at sea is deemed unique owing to its specific features and the environment in which it takes place. Unfortunately, since the development of the maritime industry, seafarers' fundamental rights have not always been considered a priority, thereby often not respected.

IMLI has been in the vanguard in raising awareness on the importance of maritime labour law standards. Indeed, the IMLI Course on Seafarers' Rights reiterates the Institute's commitment to the protection of seafarers in line with the international efforts spearheaded by IMO and ILO.

The Course is addressed to persons directly involved with maritime labour law issues. It will be particularly beneficial to policy makers and legal drafters, as well as maritime administrations' and port authorities' officers. It will also be of benefit to private practitioners who handle seafarers' rights infringements and any other person who advocates for the upholding of seafarers' rights.



The Course will be delivered in a hybrid mode, thus external participants may attend either online or in situ. Candidates who attend at least 80 per cent of the lectures will be eligible for a Certificate of Attendance.
