IMLI is pleased to share that Lloyd's Register Foundation, one of the Institute's strongest supporters, has opened applications for its latest small grants scheme. This funding opportunity offers up to £10,000 GBP for organisations who are interested in advancing the Foundation's mission of engineering a safer world.

The ethos of the Lloyd's Register Foundation small grants scheme is "a little can go a long way." Through this scheme the Foundation is making funds available to projects which can test out ideas through pilot studies, proof of concept projects or activities targeting the heritage, maritime and public sectors.

This funding opportunity is open to non-profit organisations, as well as profit organisations delivering work on a non-profit basis. Eligible applicants include registered charities, universities, and verifiable individual entities working in fields aligned with the Foundation's charitable mission.

Applicants must be able to clearly demonstrate their legal status, governance arrangements, and the relevance of their work to the Foundation's mission.
