APPLICATION PROCESS TO IMLI'S MASTER'S PROGRAMMES

Considering the numerous requests from Governments, the IMO International Maritime Law Institute (IMLI) has extended the deadline for applications to its 2026-2027 Master's programmes. Applications will now be accepted until 10 April 2026, offering aspiring professionals additional time to apply for this exceptional opportunity to acquire knowledge of the highest standards across the full range of international maritime law at a globally renowned institution.

While the Institute is very encouraged by the strong number of applications already received, it also recognizes the continuing need for national administrations to employ well-qualified maritime professionals. As the shipping sector undergoes significant transformation with a growing emphasis on sustainability, IMLI's educational mission remains vital in strengthening global capacity—particularly in Least Developed Countries and Small Island Developing States. In response to the substantial demand from governments and industry stakeholders for more time, IMLI has therefore decided to extend the deadline, allowing eligible applicants to complete and submit their applications.

In line with its policy of promoting gender balance within the maritime field, IMLI allocates 50% of available programme places to deserving women, supporting a more inclusive and diverse academic community.
